	<p>In 1 Samuel 14:18, Saul says, "Bring the ark of God." He wants to seek God's will before entering into battle with the Philistines. However, in the very next verse, after the tumult in the Philistine camp "increased more and more," he says to the priest, "Withdraw your hand."</p> <p>Have you ever, due to the urgency of the moment, decided there was no time for prayer?</p>
